“17.Thus, any of the petitioners are

aggrieved on account of the fact that their juniors are getting more pay, then they are liberty to approach the competent authority for the purpose of enhancement of their pay on par with their juniors.

19. It is made clear that if any of the petitioners are already retired from service and is a pensioner, then, recovery cannot be imposed from their pension or pensionary benefits.”.

There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
