Considering the above submissions and being satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of this application, this Court is inclined to extend the Mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal for a period of 3 months subject to the production of documents to the satisfaction of the learned Arbitrator.



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4. Accordingly, this application is allowed and the Mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal is extended for a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of copy of this order by the Arbitral Tribunal.
