Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records relating to the 1st respondent's order made in G.O.Ms.No.288, Labour and Employment (P1) Department, dated 13.12.2013, quash the same insofar as Diploma Holders are concerned, prescribing the ratio of 1 : 1 at the entry level post of Junior Training Officer (JTO) and by confining only to National Trade Certificate (NTC) Holders and consequently, appoint the petitioner as Junior Training Officer forthwith and extend all benefits.
