This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 8 days in filing the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

2. Since the first and second respondent remained absent before the Tribunal and were set *ex parte*, issuance of notice to them is dispensed with.

3. Heard Mr.G. Guruprasad, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.G.Vasudevan, learned standing counsel appearing for the third respondent.

4. Learned counsel for the third respondent did not raise any serious objection in allowing this petition.

5. Having satisfied with the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, the miscellaneous petition is allowed and the delay of 8 days in filing the above appeal is condoned.

6. Registry is directed to number the main Civil Miscellaneous Appeal, if it is otherwise in order, and list the same for admission in the usual course.

7. It is made clear that for the period of delay of 8 days, the petitioner will not be entitled for any interest if in the event of this Court enhancing the amount of compensation fixed by the Tribunal.
