Ms. No. 200, Higher Education (11) Department dated 19.12.2020 with all consequential

Considering the limited relief sought for in the petition, without expressing any opinion on merits of the writ petition, the second respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioners dated 19.09.2023 based on the proposal submitted by the third respondent in Letter No. 351/PR41/2022 dated 18.11.2020 after issuance of notice to the petitioners and counter parties, if any and after giving opportunity of hearing to them, pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

3. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
