3. It is reported by the petitioner and the second respondent that they had arrived at a settlement and the second respondent has paid a sum of Rs.5,30,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Thirty Thousand only) to the petitioner. The aforesaid settlement is recorded.

4. In view of the above settlement, the Writ Petition stands closed.
