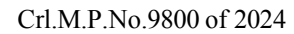

PRAYER: Criminal Miscellaneous Petition filed under Sections 389(1) of Cr.P.C., pleased to suspend the imprisonment in the judgment dated 12.06.2024 in Special C.C.No.06 of 2014 on the file of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tiruppur and enlarge the petitioner/appellant on bail pending disposal of the criminal appeal.

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Appeal. In view of the same, he pleaded that the sentence imposed upon the petitioner/appellant may be suspended and the petitioner/appellant may be enlarged on bail. He further submitted that the trial Court, while convicting the petitioner has suspended the sentence till the disposal of the appeal.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the prosecution has proved the case beyond reasonable doubts and the trial Court on finding the petitioner/appellant guilty, convicted him as stated above. Therefore, he vehemently opposed for grant of suspension of sentence.

5. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/appellant and Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent and perused the materials available on record.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking into account of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner/appellant, this Court is of the view that the sentence of imprisonment can be suspended on certain conditions. Accordingly, till the



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disposal of the Criminal Appeal, suspension of sentence is granted, on the following conditions :-

- i. The petitioner/appellant shall execute bond for a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only), with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tiruppur;
- ii. The petitioner/appellant shall appear before the trial Court on the first working day of every English Calendar month at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

7. Accordingly, the Criminal Miscellaneous Petition stands ordered.
