4. It is the case of the writ petitioner that the seventh respondent in collusion with the officials had changed the patta and also alienated the trust property. In this regard, he has given an appeal petition before the District Revenue Officer/second respondent on 18.05.2024 against the order of the third respondent, which is pending without consideration till date. Such exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
