This petition has been filed to enlarge the petitioner on bail in crime No. 269 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the deceased purchased Nitrovet and Tydol tablets from the accused persons and injected into his body through syringe and thereafter died. Hence, the case.
