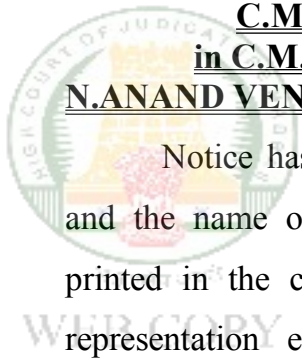

Notice has been served on first respondent and the name of first respondent has also been printed in the cause list. However, there is no representation either in person or through a counsel.

2. The respondents 2 and 3 are represented through counsel.

3. This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 333 days in filing the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the records.

5. Having satisfied with the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, this miscellaneous petition is allowed and the delay of 333 days in filing the above appeal is condoned.

Registry is directed to print the name of Mr.N.Soma Sundar, learned counsel for second respondent and Mrs.R.Sreevidhya, learned counsel for third respondent at the time of admission.

It is made clear that for the period of delay of 333 days, the appellants will not be entitled for any interest if in the event of this Court enhancing the amount of compensation fixed by the Tribunal.
