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This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 30 days in filing the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

3. Though notice was served on the 2nd respondent and their name was printed in the cause list, there is no representation on their behalf.

5. Having satisfied with the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, this petition is allowed and the delay of 30 days in filing the above appeal is condoned.
