This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed to grant further extension of time to comply with the order of this Court, dated 18.05.2023 in Crl.M.P.No.7195 of 2023 in Crl.R.C.No.359 of 2023.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that due to financial crises, the petitioner was not able to comply with the order of this Court, dated 28.02.2023 in Crl.R.C.No.359 of 2023, hence, the petitioner filed first extension of time petition in Crl.M.P.No.7198 of 2023 in Crl.R.C.No.359 of 2023 before this Court and this Court was pleased to extend the time for further two weeks on 18.05.2023. Due to vacation time, the petitioner could not comply with the order, hence, he filed the present second extension of time petition.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent Police strongly opposed this petition stating that already this
