This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 76 days in filing the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

2. Since the respondents 1 and 2 remained absent before the Tribunal and were set *exparte*, issuance of notice to the respondents 1 and 2 is dispensed with.

3. Mr.D.Venkatachalam, learned counsel appearing for the Respondents 3 and 4 did not raise any serious objection in allowing the petition.

4.Having satisfied with the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, the miscellaneous petition is allowed and the delay of 76 days in filing the above appeal is condoned.

5. Registry is directed to number the main Civil Miscellaneous Appeal, if it is otherwise in order and list the same for admission in due course.

6. It is made clear that for the period of delay of 76 days, the petitioner / appellant will not be entitled for any interest if in the event of this Court enhancing the amount of compensation fixed by the Tribunal.
