ORDER

The writ of mandamus has been instituted to direct the respondents to allot one medical seat to the petitioner, during the academic year 2020 – 2021, on compassionate ground, by considering the ill health of the petitioner.

Since the academic year 2020 – 2021 had been completed, the relief sought for in the present writ petition lost its relevance. Therefore, no further adjudication is required in this matter.
