This case came up for settlement before the National Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. The learned counsel for the appellant for **Mr.K.J.Sivakumar** and **Mr.P.Murali** learned counsel for the respondents are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:



TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

This appeal has been filed by the Transport Corporation challenging the award dated **23.12.2021**, for a sum of **Rs.2,72,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Seventy Two thousand only)** with interest at 7.5% from the date of petition till the date of deposit of compensation and costs.

2. The respondent/claimant and the learned counsel representing the appellant/Transport Corporation are present before the Lok Adalat. The Tribunal has awarded a sum of **Rs.2,72,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Seventy Two thousand only)** together with interest at the rate of 7.5% p.a. from the date of petition till the date of deposit of compensation. Pursuant to the Award, the appellant has deposited a sum of **Rs.2,16,851/-** representing 50% of the Award amount along with interest. Parties have agreed to settle the entire dispute at **Rs.3,70,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Seventy Thousand only)** in full quit.

3. Accordingly, the balance sum of **Rs.1,53,149/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Three Thousand One Hundred and Forty Nine only)** shall be deposited before the **Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Puducherry, to the credit of MCOP No.330 of 2015**, within a period of **eight** weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
