The petitioners apprehend arrest for the alleged offences under Section 318(4) of BNS Act, 2023 in Crime No.: Not Known, on the file of the respondent police seek anticipatory bail.

2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent police would submit that no case has been registered against the petitioner. It was further stated that an inquiry into the petitioner based on the complaint filed by the defacto complainant is ongoing, and assurance was given that the inquiry related to the earlier petition will be completed as early as possible in accordance with law.
