The governing committee of the appropriate agencies shall form an inquiry committee abruptly under the provisions of appropriate law and rule to take appropriate actions against the third and fourth respondents i.e. the management of Billroth Hospital and Dr. Chakravarthy.

Considering the limited relief sought for in the petition, without expressing any opinion on merits of the writ petition, the second respondent is directed to conduct enquiry after issuance of notice to the petitioner and the fourth respondent and after giving opportunity of hearing to them, pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

3. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed. No costs.
