

**O.P. No.17 of 2023**

This Petition has been filed under Sections 232 and 276 of the Indian Succession Act read with Order XXV Rule 5 of the Original Side Rules, seeking to grant of Letters of Administration.

2. This petition has been filed for grant of Letters Administration in respect of the estate of one late Mr.C.Yogendran. The first petitioner is the wife and the second and fourth petitioners are the sons and the third petitioner is the daughter of the deceased Mr.C.Yogendran. The deceased C.Yogendran died on 10.05.2021. The petitioners are the Class-I legal heirs of the deceased. The deceased died intestate and though due and diligent search has been made for a Will, nothing has been found. There is no other kith or kin available than the petitioners. The amount of assets which is likely to come to the petitioners' hand do not exceed in the aggregate sum of Rs.10,00,000/- and the net amount of the said assets after deducting all the items, which the petitioners are by law allowed to deduct is only of the



value of Rs.10,00,000/-. The petitioners undertake to duly administer the property and credits of the deceased C.Yogendran and to make a full and true inventory thereof and exhibit the same to the Court within six months from the date of grant of Letters of Administration to the petitioners and also render a true account of the said property and credits within one year from the said date.

3. The fourth petitioner has been examined as P.W.1. P.W.1 in his evidence had narrated the averments made in the petition stating that the petitioners have filed this petition for grant of Letters of Administration in favour of the petitioners in respect of the estate of the deceased Mr.C.Yogendran. Exs.P.1 to P.5 are the photocopies of the Aadhar Card of the deceased and the petitioners herein. Ex.P6 is the computer generated death certificate of the deceased. Ex.P.6 has been filed to prove that the deceased died on 10.05.2021. Ex.P.7 is the legal heirship certificate of the deceased. Ex.P.7 has been filed to prove that the petitioners are the legal heirs of the deceased. Exs.P.8 & P.9 are the photocopies of the letters sent by SBI, MKB Nagar Branch, Chennai addressed to the fourth petitioner seeking for Letters of Administration. Ex.P10 is the affidavit of assets



showing the net value of the estates as Rs.10,00,000/-. Exs.P.11 & P.12 are the paper publications, but none have objected for the same.

4. In view of the above facts, I am of the view that the petitioners have proved their claim and hence, the petitioners are entitled for the issuance of Letters of Administration in their favour.

5. Accordingly, this petition is allowed. Issue Letters of Administration in favour of the petitioners. The petitioners are directed to duly administer the properties and credits of the deceased more fully described in the schedule. The petitioners are also directed to execute a security bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) in favour of the Assistant Registrar (O.S.II), High Court, Madras. The petitioners are further directed to render true and correct accounts once in a year.
