It is found that the petitioner herein fortified the Court decree, whereas the respondents who have agreed to produce the documents in their favour, have not turned up. Hence the complaint given by the petitioner was closed as civil in nature. He further states that the respondent police is keeping vigil over the matter and if any reasonable evidence available for proceed against the private respondents for causing life threat, necessary action will be taken.
