Mr.R.Neethi perumal, learned counsel, takes notice for 2nd respondent. Though notice has been served and the name of 1st respondent has also been printed in the cause-list, there is no appearance on behalf of the 1st respondent.

2. This Civil Miscellaneous petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 176 days in filing the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the Appellants and perused the records.

4. Having satisfied with the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, the miscellaneous petition is allowed and the delay of 176 days is condoned.

5. Registry is directed to number the main Civil miscellaneous appeal and list the same for admission, if it is otherwise in order. When the matter is posted for admission, the name of learned counsel for 2nd respondent shall be printed in the cause-list.

6. It is made clear that for the period of delay of 176 days, the appellants will not be entitled for any interest if in the event of this Court enhancing the amount of compensation fixed by the Tribunal.
