Prayer : Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents 1 to 4 to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 18.07.2024 seeking permission to run a petty/bunk shop since 14.04.2009 in a small



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size of 5 x 5 on Kancheepuram Railway Road within Arappananjary Village boundary for more than 15 years on the side of road about 100 feet wide without any road obstruction for public. I bring biscuits, bread and home made tea in flasks used by the public and sell the products at a low price to the public who come to the small scale hospital, bus stop or any other nearby area, enabling the petitioner to make out some earnings to run the petitioner's family.
