Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records pertaining to the impugned order of dismissal from service passed by the fourth respondent vide order dated 16.09.1997 in Ref.No.P-VIII-9/97-97-Estt-II and confirmed by the third respondent vide proceedings dated 09.11.2003 in Ref.No.R-XIII.1/03-ESTT-I and dismissal of his revision petition in ref No.R-XIII-1/2015-SZ-Legal dated 28.06.2016 and to quash the same as illegal, arbitrary, contrary to law and violative of audi alteram partem and direct the respondents to pay attendant service benefits to the petitioner within a time frame fixed by this Court and for other consequential orders.
