to the petitioner under these heads through information dated 23.08.2023 and 19.01.2024. Since the amount due and payable towards the encasement of earned leave and STERBS Fund were not paid to the petitioner, the present writ petition has been filed seeking for appropriate directions.

4.Heard Mr.G.Vijay Priyan, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr.C.Gouthamaraj, learned Standing Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent.

5.Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the RTI information dated 23.08.2023 and 19.01.2024 that were furnished to the petitioner, there shall be a direction to the respondent Corporation to settle the eligible amount due and payable towards the encashment of 15 days earned leave and STERBS Fund, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order with 6% interest from the date of retirement till the date of actual realisation. If there is any delay in settling the amount within the time frame fixed by this Court, the respondent Corporation will be liable to pay interest at the rate of 12% from the date of retirement till the date of actual realisation.
