The delay of 692 days in filing the petition to set aside the abatement caused by the death of the 1st respondent is condoned, the abatement caused by the death of the 1st respondent is set aside and the respondents 7 and 8 are brought on record as the legal representatives of the deceased 1st respondent and ranked as respondents 7 and 8 in the main appeal.
