ORDER

This writ petition has been filed directing the Respondents to declare that the petitioners are entitled to be appointed as Teachers (Secondary Grade/B.T. Assistant) who completed certificate verification, recruitment being made on the basis of TET Mark and TET passed year seniority without resorting to any competitive examination as



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stated in the GO Ms. No 149 dated 20.07.2018 as a measure of equality and fairness as well as on foundation of the doctrine of promissory estoppels and legitimate expectation.

2.The issue that is involved in this writ petition was already considered by the learned Single Judge of this Court in W.P.No.161 of 2024. By order dated 08.01.2024, the writ petition was dismissed. Following this order, yet another order was passed by this Court in W.P.No.6245 of 2024, dated 11.03.2024.

3.In the light of the above development, there is nothing to be considered in this writ petition and this writ petition must also fail in the light of the order passed in W.P.No.161 of 2024, dated 08.01.2024 and accordingly, this writ petition stand dismissed. No costs.
