Santhome, Chennai on 10.03.1999 and she continuously renewed the same without any default till 2010. While so, due to several hardships faced by the petitioner, she failed to renew her employment registration for about three years and thereafter, as the offline renewal option was not available, the petitioner was unable to proceed further. Therefore, the petitioner sent a representation dated 05.08.2024 to the 1st respondent, seeking to permit the petitioner to renew her old registration No.WPB12451/99 as on date, which evoked no response. Hence, this Writ petition.

4. Though very many grounds have been raised, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would suffice if this Court issues direction to the 1st respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 05.08.2024 and to consequently permit her to renew her old registration No.WPB12451/99 as on date.

5. Learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents submitted that, appropriate orders will be passed on the petitioner's representation dated 05.08.2024 within the time stipulated by this Court.

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6. In view of the aforesaid submissions, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case directs the 1st respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 05.08.2024 on merits and in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after affording an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, this Writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
