The learned counsel for the appellant Mr.S.Sankaralingam and the learned counsel for the 2nd respondents Mr.R.V.Sivaraj is present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the



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TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

Both the parties and their respective counsel are present.

2. The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.3,13,500/(Rupees Three lakh thirteen thousand and five hundred only) with interest at 7.5% p.a. from the date of petition till the date of deposit as compensation.

3. Aggrieved by the award, the appellant has preferred the present appeal. Now the claimants have agreed to receive a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- (Rupees four Lakhs and fifty thousand only) in addition to the amount awarded by the Tribunal in full quit, which is also acceptable by the 2nd respondent.

4. The 2nd respondent is directed to deposit the award amount, now ordered after deducting any amount already deposited, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Award is passed accordingly.

5. The Tribunal is directed to issue the award amount through NEFT/RTGS to the party concerned on proper identification in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition.

6.The appeal is ordered accordingly.
