ORDER

Pursuant to our order dated 22nd October, 2024, the present Commissioner, Mr.Ranjeet Singh, is present in Court and is identified by Ms.N.Devi, counsel for first respondent. The said Ranjeet Singh has filed an affidavit dated 24th October, 2024 tendering apology for not obeying the orders within the time as directed by the Court and also for not approaching the Court to extend the time.
