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regarding the property measuring 1.19 Acre (one acre and nineteen cents) and building, thereupon the 3rd respondent has already instituted a suit in the year 2016 and the same is pending in O.S.No.116 of 2016, on the file of the District Munsif Court, Gobichettipalayam. Suppressing the said fact, the 3rd respondent also gave a complaint to Gobichettipalayam police station which was enquired and closed thereupon.
