There has been a concerted effort from many vested interest to some how stop the recruitment process. This Court had the opportunity to deal with one such case yesterday in Cont.P.No.2387 of 2024.

3. This Court is not inclined to grant the relief as sought for by the petitioner. The petitioner is yet another person who has attempted to come before this Court and stop the recruitment process by raising unsustainable grounds.
