These petitions have been filed seeking condonation of delay of 26 days in seeking to set aside the abatement caused due to the death of the sole respondent in the Appeal, to set aside the abatement and to bring on record the legal representatives of the deceased sole respondent as respondents 2 to 5 in the Appeal.
