When the petitioner's sister, namely, V.Jothi, aged about 42 years, had gone missing, he had given a complaint on 09.08.2023 before the second respondent Police. The petitioner has also given a complaint dated 23.08.2023 to first respondent/Commissioner. Since the petitioner's sister could not be traced within a reasonable time, he has filed the present Habeas Corpus Petition.

2. Today, when the matter was called, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner's complaint has been registered in Crime No.345/2023 on 08.08.2023 as 'woman missing' and that the second respondent Police is conducting the investigation to locate the petitioner's sister.

3. Since the second respondent Police had registered the petitioner's complaint and are in the process of investigating the same, we deem it fit that the second respondent could be directed to expedite the investigation

and file a final report.

4. In view of this decision, the prayer sought for in the present Habeas Corpus Petition does not require consideration. Accordingly, there shall be a direction to the second respondent herein, to expedite the investigation in Crime No.345/2023 and file a final report, as expeditiously as possible.

5. With the above direction, the Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.
