ORDER

The matter had been referred to Mediation on 21.08.2024. The parties have settled the matter before the Mediator and the settlement agreement has also been presented to the Court. Settlement agreement entered into between the parties is extracted hereunder:

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT entered into on between, T.Santhos Kumar Son of M.Thiyagarajan, residing at No.15/8, 6th street, Rajamanagaram, Vellore, Chennai - 49, hereinafter called the 1st PARTY, And Mrs.Venakshini daughter of K.Vasudevan residing at No.7 MGR Nagar, Porur, Chennai 601204, hereinafter called the 2nd PARTY.

WHEREAS

1. Disputes and differences had arisen between the Parties hereto and the 1st party filed a divorce petition in H.M.O.P.No.322 of 2021, against the 2nd party, and the 2nd party filed a petition for restitution of conjugal rights in H.M.O.P.No.3253 of 2021, before the Hon'ble 3rd Additional Family court at Chennai, and the 2nd party filed a petition for interim maintenance, and due to non payment of maintenance the H.M.O.P.No.322 of 2021 was dismissed and H.M.O.P.No.3253 of 2021, was allowed by the Hon'ble 3rd Additional Family court at Chennai, and the 2nd party again preferred E.P.No.66 of 2022 in the result on payment of the entire arrears amount the said E.P. was terminated by the hon'ble family court, while pending the said EP the 2nd party filed another E.P.No.23 of 2023, for further arrears, so the 1st party filed the CRP No.1758 of 2023, before the Hon'ble High Court, also filed another CRP No.4015 of 23, against the order of return of Arrears.

2. The matter was referred to mediation/conciliation vide an order dated 21/08/2024 & 24/10/2024, passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras.

3. The parties agreed that M.Jayapalan (M) would act as their Mediator/Conciliator.

4. Several meetings were held during the process of Mediation/Conciliation from 15/09/2024 to 06/12/2024 and the parties have with the assistance of the Mediator / Conciliator voluntarily arrived at an amicable solution resolving the above mentioned disputes and differences.

5. The parties hereto confirm and declare that they have voluntarily and of their own free will arrived at this Settlement Agreement in the presence of the Mediator/Conciliator.

6. The following settlement has been arrived at between the Parties hereto:

A. Both the parties mutually agreed to continue their matrimonial life on their own will and the 1st party agreed to fix a separate house on his convenient place on or before February 2025, and both of them mutually and voluntarily decided to live as husband and wife, and both the parties jointly and mutually agreed that they will not create any unwanted disputes in future.

B. The 1st party agreed to withdraw the C.R.P.No.1758 of 2023 & C.R.P.No.4015 of 2023, since the dispute is settled before the mediation.
