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ORDER

The petitioners, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 06.09.2024, for the offences punishable under Section 318(4) of BNS, and Sections 51(b)(i) and 63(a) of the Copyright Act, in Crime No.286 of 2024, on the file of the respondent seek bail.

2.It is the case of the prosecution that the defacto complainant is the Senior Manager at M/s.E.I.P.R (India) Pvt., Ltd., having its registered office at Unit 14A & 14B, Mittal Chambers, First Floor, 228, Nariman Point, Mumbai – 21 and that he has come to the knowledge that the petitioner along with the other accused had involved in manufacturing and selling duplicate polycab electrical wires in the godown at SPN Public School Complex, Mill Road, Sukarawarpet, Townhall, Coimbatore, without any authorization from the said Company. Hence, the case.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this



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case. He would further submit that the petitioners have been in judicial custody from 06.09.2024. He would submit that there is no previous case against the petitioners. He would also submit that the petitioners are ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he prays for grant of bail to the petitioners.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) would submit that the petitioners along with the other accused, colluded together and manufactured and selling duplicate polycab electrical wires in the godown at SPN Public School Complex, Mill Road, Sukarawarpet, Townhall, Coimbatore, without any authorization from M/s.E.I.P.R (India) Pvt., Ltd. He would further submit that there is no previous case against the petitioners. However, he vehemently opposed to grant bail to the petitioners.

5. Heard both side learned counsel and perused the materials available on record.



6. Considering the nature of offences charged against the petitioners, no previous case is pending against the petitioners and also taking into consideration the number of days of incarceration undergone by the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

[a] Accordingly, the Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **Judicial Magistrate No.1, Coimbatore**, and on further conditions that;

[b] the Petitioners shall report before the respondent police everyday at 10.30 a.m., for a period of 30 days and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the Petitioners shall not commit any offences of similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, or of the commission of which he is suspected;

[d] the Petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

[e] the Petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the Petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have



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been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]; and

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 B.N.S.
