ORDER

The Petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody
on 22.08.2024, for the alleged offences punishable under Section 103 of



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BNS, 2023 in Crime No.264 of 2024, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that, due to illicit relationship, there was a wordy quarrel between the deceased and the petitioner. On 19.08.2024, at about 11.00 p.m, the petitioner murdered his wife and locked the house door and escaped from his house. Hence, the complaint.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that this is the second bail petition filed by the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. He would further submit that the petitioner was arrested and is in judicial custody from 22.08.2024 and is ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he prayed bail for the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that there was an illegal relationship with the deceased and one police officer, and on the date of the alleged occurrence,



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when the deceased was talking over phone to him, a wordy quarrel arose between them, due to this, the petitioner with the help of a pillow, committed murder and further he locked the house door and escaped from his house. He further submits that the petitioner has no previous cases, pending against him and the investigation in this case is almost completed. Hence, he opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

6. Considering the nature of offence, considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner from 22.08.2024, and the petitioner has no previous cases pending against him, investigation is almost completed, and also considering all others factors, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned



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Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ulundurpet, and on further conditions that:-

[a] the petitioner shall report before the concerned Jurisdictional Magistrate on all working days at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

[b] the Petitioner shall not commit any offences of similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, or of the commission of which he is suspected;

[c] the Petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

[d] the Petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the Petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]; and



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[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 B.N.S.
