3. The petitioner has approached the 2nd respondent with a representation to cancel the Pattas that has been issued in the name of respondents 4 to 7 in Patta No.488 and 622 respectively and thereafter survey and sub-divide the property and issue Patta in the name of the petitioner.

4. The petitioner claims right to the property in question on the basis of a Settlement Deed executed by his mother, sisters and brothers on 02.03.2020 in his favour. The petitioner has been in possession and enjoyment of the same since then. The property originally belonged to his father Arunachalam. The petitioner would submit that though the joint patta had been granting in favour of the petitioner, his father and his paternal uncle Annamalai and the names of the respondents 4 to 7 who are not connected with the petitioner or his family members has been issued with the patta.
