This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 85 days in filing the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

2. Since the second respondent remained absent before the Tribunal and was set *exparte*, issuance of notice to the second respondent is dispensed with.
