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This Writ Petition has been filed seeking a mandamus, to direct the respondent/Police to issue a Non-Traceable Certificate of certain property documents, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 14.10.2023.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent-Police, on instructions, would submit that the Director General of Police had issued a Circular vide Rc.No.2029209/General.1 (1)/2022, dated 01.04.2022 to all the Police stations, giving guidelines as to how the request for Non-Traceable Certificate has to be considered.

3. Therefore, considering the said submission, the respondent/Police is directed to consider the petitioner's representation dated 14.10.2023, in terms of the Circular of the Director General of Police dated 01.04.2022, within a period of four weeks.

4. With the above observation, this Writ Petition stands ordered. There
