PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus, directing the respondents to produce the detenu named Soundaranayagi aged about 21 years D/o. Velmurugan, now under illegal detention of third respondent and set her at liberty.

ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by *S.M.SUBRAMANIAM, J.*)

The writ of habeas corpus petition has been filed to direct the respondents to produce the detenu *viz.*, Soundaranayagi, aged about 21 years, who is under illegal detention of the third respondent.

2. The second respondent/Inspector of Police produced the detenu before this Court along with the third respondent. The detenu completed B.A. degree in English Literature and with consent married the third respondent at Tiruppur. She says that now she is leading matrimonial

life along with the third respondent at Tiruppur and the third respondent is working as Electrician.

3. In view of the fact that the detinue is not under illegal detention, no further adjudication needs to be undertaken and consequently, the Habeas Corpus Petition stands **disposed of**.
