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order of detention passed by the second respondent as against the son of the petitioner herein dated 30.09.2023 has been revoked by the Government in G.O. [Rt] No.6530, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XI) Department, dated 22.11.2023 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.
