ORDER

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This Writ petition has been filed by the petitioner to transfer the investigation to special team (to be constituted by the 2nd respondent).

2. This Court, through an order dated 19.10.2024 in CrI.O.P.No.28547 of 2022 and an order dated 24.09.2024 in CrI.O.P. No.28541 of 2022, quashed the FIRs in Cr.
