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Affidavit of service has been filed. Notice has been served on the counsel who appeared on behalf of the claimant before the Tribunal. There is no appearance either in person or through counsel for respondents 1 to 3.

2.The 4th respondent remained ex-parte even before the Tribunal and hence, notice is dispensed with.

3.Even though, this Court is not satisfied with the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of the petition to condone the exorbitant delay of 1371 days, it was contended that this was a case of no insurance. Hence, the delay is condoned with a condition that the entire award amount along with accrued interest shall be deposited, within a period of four weeks from today, failing which, this petition shall stand automatically dismissed without any further reference to this Court.
