ORDER

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and in view of the limited request sought for by the petitioner, this court directs the petitioner to make a fresh representation to the respondents along with all the relevant documents and also a copy of this order within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Upon receipt of which, the respondents shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders within a period of four weeks thereafter.

6. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
