**PRAYER:** Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail in Cr.No. 224 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police.

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4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) objected for granting bail to the petitioner stating that totally there are two accused and this petitioner has been arrayed as A-1 and he along with other accused went to the defacto complainant's shop and robbed a sum of Rs.340/- at a knife point and there are six previous cases against the petitioner.

5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record.

6. Considering the submissions made on both sides, considering the nature of offences, the money involved in this case and also taking into consideration the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner from 08.10.2024 and though the petitioner is having six previous cases, in all those cases, he was granted bail and those cases are not similar kind of offences, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions:

[a]. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the court of ***II Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore, Chennai***, and on further conditions that:



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**[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders;**

**[c]** The petitioner shall attend in accordance with the conditions of the bond;

**[d]** The petitioner shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, or of the commission of which he is suspected;

**[e]** The petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

**[f]** the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer or tamper with evidence;



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[g] on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]; and

[h] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of the BNS.
