Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records/ Proceedings of the 2nd respondent in G.O.(Ms) No.7, School Education (V13) Department dated 04.01.2000, G.O (Ms) No.176, School Education (SE2(2) Department dated 21.07.2017 and proceedings of the 1st respondent in G.O (Ms) No.140, School Education (HS2) Department, dated 19.05.2010 and proceedings of the 4th respondent in Na.Ka.No.75050/V1/E2/2017 dated 24.08.2017 by which the petitioner is totally prohibited and deprived of his rights to secure the employment in Government service as Teacher of Post Graduate Assistant in Computer Science or Computer Instructors, as the case may be in Government Higher Secondary Schools in Tamil Nadu based on his qualification of M.Sc. Computer Science with B.Ed., and quashing the same and direct the 1st and 2nd respondents to issue fresh Government order based on the NCTE Regulation 2014 framed by National Council for Teacher Education and also based on Section 23(1) of RTE Act 2009 which is compulsory and mandatory and to fix a



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time frame for the appointment of the Computer Teacher.
