This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 420 days in filing the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

2. Heard Mr.K. Varadhakamaraj, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/claimant.

3. Mr.S.S.Santhosh Kumar, learned counsel who undertakes to file vakalat on behalf of the respondent Transport Corporation did not raise any serious objection in allowing this petition.

4.Having satisfied with the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, the miscellaneous petition is allowed and the delay of 420 days in filing the above appeal is condoned.

5. Registry is directed to number the main Civil Miscellaneous Appeal, if it is otherwise in order, and print the name of Mr.S.S.Santhosh Kumar as counsel for the respondent at the time of admission.

6. It is made clear that for the period of delay of 420 days, the petitioner will not be entitled for any interest if in the event of this Court enhancing the amount of compensation fixed by the Tribunal.
