The petitioner is the cousin of the detenu viz., Kali @ Arunachalam, son of Karuppan, aged about 26 years, confined at Central Prison, Vellore, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order passed by the second respondent dated 15.10.2023 slapped on him, branding him as



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"Goonda" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 [Tamil Nadu Act, 14 of 1982].

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the order of detention passed by the second respondent as against the petitioner herein dated 15.10.2023 has been revoked by the Government in G.O.Rt.No.6763, Home, Prohibition and Excise (IX) Department, dated 01.12.2023 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.

3.Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this petition is dismissed as the same has become infructuous.
