PRAYER:- Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records in the name of the Managing Director of the Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board in Lr.No.CMWSSB/P&A/RA2/21826/2016 dated 22.09.2016 and quash the same and direct the respondent to promote the petitioner notionally as Senior Accounts Officer as the petitioner was qualified and approved for inclusion in the Panel by the Board of Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board as on 26.02.2016, notwithstanding that the petitioner retired on superannuation on 29.02.2016 afternoon, so as to enable the petitioner to get little more

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pensionary benefits and pass further orders.
