PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the Respondents to pay interest to the petitioner at the rate of 18% per annum for the belated payment of 830 days in paying the PF, gratuity and earned leave salary with interest at the rate of 18% within a specified time as fixed by this Court and pass orders.

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ORDER

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By consent of both parties, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the Respondents to pay interest to the petitioner at the rate of 18% per annum for the belated payment of 830 days in paying the PF, gratuity and earned leave salary with interest at the rate of 18%

3. The case of the petitioner is that the husband of the petitioner is an retired employee from the Respondent/Corporation. The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondent settled the retirement benefits to the husband of the petitioner on 01.12.2022, whereas the actual retirement date was 05.08.2020 i.e after a delay of 830 days. Hence, the petitioner made a representation to the respondent on 09.10.2024 to pay interest for the belated payment. However, no action has been taken by the respondent till date. Hence this petition.



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4.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would be suffice if this Court issues a direction to the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders.

5. The learned standing counsel appearing for the respondent submitted that the representation of the petitioner will be considered and will pay the eligible amount with 6% interest P.A as per the earlier orders of this Court.

6. Considering the facts of the case, this Court on submission made by either side counsel directs the respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner and pass orders on the claim made by the petitioner within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this Order. With regard to interest for the belated payment it will be 6% interest per annum interest from the date on which the amount became due and payable till the date of disbursement. It is made clear that if the amount is not paid within the time frame fixed by this Court, the same will carry interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the date on



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which the amount became due and payable till the date of disbursement.

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7. With the above directions, this Writ Petition stands disposed of.
