This order will now dispose of the captioned 'Writ Miscellaneous Petition' [hereinafter 'WMP' for the sake of brevity].

2. Captioned WMP has been filed with a prayer to dispense with production of 'certified copy of the impugned eviction notice dated 21.10.2024 passed by the third respondent' [hereinafter 'impugned notice' for the sake of brevity, convenience and clarity].

3. Mr.N.Chinnaraj, learned counsel on record for writ petitioner is before this Court.

4. Learned counsel for writ petitioner submits that the original impugned notice is not readily available with the petitioner at the time of filing of the writ petition but a photo copy of the impugned notice is filed along with the typed set of papers and that has necessitated the captioned WMP.
